This beautifully illustrated pictorial Bible uses illustrations (panoramas) to serves as mnemonics, or memory aids, for stories throughout the Bible. Our first volume includes 12 panoramas and covers 35 Bible stories beginning with Creation and ending with the Great Commission.

Traditionally, illiterate communities and oral-based cultures pass information from person to person through stories. The *Wordless Panoramic Bible* is an effective evangelism and discipleship tool specifically developed for these cultures. The Bible stories are individually taught and distributed to both adults and children within unreached and unchurched regions.

With all 12 panoramas complete, we are now ready to print, train and equip, and distribute this vital resource for short-term mission teams, mission agencies, and national missionaries. **Over the next 2 years our costs will be an estimated \$35,000 to produce the necessary elements for distribution and training.**
